## **Mexico Mission Trip**

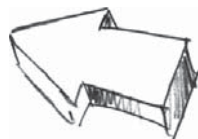

## **New Ministry: Caring and Sharing Support Group**

The group makes periodic contact with identified church members via phone calls, emails and text messages, cards and written notes, personal visits, and by praying and reading scripture together.
