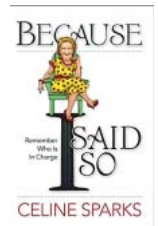

Big Idea: Jesus and Jonah walk similar paths but reveal opposing lifestyles.

1) Jesus is a prophet from the north born in the south. Why is this important for understanding who Jesus is?

Compare Jonah 1:1-6 with Mark 4:35-41

2) What is similar in these stories? What is different?

a) What is Jesus' motivation for sleeping during the storm? What does this show about him?

Read Matthew 12:38-41

3) What is the sign of Jonah?

a) How are the Pharisees contrasted by the Ninevites?

b) How are the Pharisees like Jonah?

Small Group Material

4) The Pharisees will see Jesus rise and still not believe. Can you think of someone who experienced the love of Christ and yet did not put their faith in Jesus? Why did they walk away?

a) How should we respond to others like them?

Read Matthew 9: 35-39

5) How do you respond to Jesus' invitation in this passage? What have you done recently to walk the path of Jesus for others?

Read Matthew 23:37

6) Jesus reveals his concern for Jerusalem, even as He severely chastises the Pharisees. Unlike Jonah, Jesus does not wish destruction on us; in fact, He takes destruction for us. Spend some time in prayer thanking Christ for His sacrifice.

7) Walk through the Paths of Jonah and Paths of Jesus on the last page in the bulletin. You can do this with friends or on your own.

90 Day Challenge

Vice to Virtue

We are a little over the halfway mark in our 90 Days of Virtues and Vices. If this is the first you've heard of this, that's ok. This isn't a major church-wide program or anything. It is simply something I encouraged people to do at the end of our series on the 7 Deadly Vices. If you haven't been pursuing a virtue then I invite you to pick a virtue and strengthen it in your life.

But what if you did start working on a virtue but stalled? What if you made your plan, had your spiritual exercise picked out but then dropped it? What do you do? That's what this article is about. And the answer to this is simple: get back to it. It's not uncommon for people to make a plan and then not follow through...it's actually a very normal part of the human experience. But if we just let our virtue drop and we don't pick it back up again then we'll never grow.

So if you're still pursuing your virtue, great!! Keep it up and follow Jesus. If you haven't started pursuing a virtue over a vice, then why not start now? And if you stopped your pursuit, then pick it back up and keep growing. I leave you with two verses that encourage me when I feel like I've failed or stalled in my pursuit of Jesus.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Ephesians 2:8-10 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast. ¹⁰ For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared.
